Updates from CCC

Afterschool for the 2022-2023 School Year

December marks the beginning of CCC's very busy enrollment period. Families will soon be receiving applications for next school year's infant, toddler and preschool classes. As you know, this year we suspended our Afterschool program in response to the COVID pandemic. During this time, the Concord Recreation Department has been able to provide after school programming at each elementary school.

Unfortunately, given the uncertainties regarding continued COVID restrictions and the availability of the Town's recreation programs, CCC will not offer an Afterschool program during the 2022-23 school year. We are very disappointed to not offer Afterschool next year and hope that once COVID is well and truly out of the picture, we will be able to resume the program at West Concord and Ripley. The Concord Recreation Department will continue to offer its Afterschool program at each elementary school. You can find more information on the Recreation Department [website](#).

The schedule for applying for next year's Infant, Toddler and preschool programs is as follows:

- Week of December 13: 2022-2023 applications sent to families.
- January 10: all applications are due.
- February 7: acceptance letters and enrollment agreements sent to families.

Updated Snow Day Policy

Winter is upon us, which means it is time to remind families of our approach to inclement weather. The policy has changed since last year, so please take a few minutes to read the information below.

CCC is closed on Concord Public School snow days. These are announced on the major Boston area radio and television stations, posted on their websites, and also posted on the **Concord Public Schools website**. In the event of a closure, CCC will also notify families and staff via Kaymbu and post this info on our **website** and **Facebook page**.

If Concord Public Schools delay opening, Concord Children's Center will also delay opening by the equivalent time. Our hours of operation are 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM; therefore, if CPS delays opening one hour, Concord Children's Center will open at 8:00 AM.

In the event the Concord Public Schools close early due to inclement weather, Concord Children's Center will not necessarily close early. If CCC administration determines it is necessary to close early, parents will be notified at drop off, if possible, or by telephone, text, and/or email later in the day. We will give parents as much lead time as possible. We recommend parents always have a backup plan for your child's pick up in the event you cannot make it to your child's program on time.

During public school vacation weeks and other days that Concord Public Schools are closed and CCC is open, CCC administration will decide before 7AM to either close or delay our opening because of

severe weather. We will contact families either by email or by telephone and leave a message on the phones at all sites.

Sustainability

Building a new school is exciting for many reasons including the opportunity to create a building that is sustainable and supportive of the environment. With the future of our young students in mind, we seek to incorporate “green” principles into our design for our new site at 250 Bedford Road. Our wish list includes the following sustainability measures:

- A building envelope that will exceed the base code requirements;
- All-electric heating and cooling;
- Energy-saving appliances;
- Use of materials with recycled content and supportive of healthy indoor air quality;



- Infrastructure to support solar panels;
- Sustainable landscape that maximizes the diversity of native species, and pollinator habitat.

We have been working with consultants from [RMF Engineering](#) to identify how to best achieve these “green goals” within our budget. Over the next month our design team will complete the drawings required to obtain an estimate of the cost of the project. We will keep our community posted as progress continues.
