I am proud to share the 2018 Report of Giving for Concord Children's Center. As I reflect on the success of this past year, I am reminded of other past successes and the vision we have for Concord Children's Center going forward.

This year we enthusiastically acknowledge the 20 years since the CCC Board set out on an ambitious effort to build a new school at 1300 Main Street. The journey from tenant at Harvey Wheeler to owning our own building at 1300 Main Street, opened in September 2002, was truly an adventure. Successfully completing this project allowed CCC to continue to operate three sites and grow our programs. At the same time, we have been gradually rebuilding our reserves, much of which, along with a successful capital campaign, financed the construction of 1300 Main Street. Twenty years later, we remain financially stable, able to support our mission, and looking forward to the next 20 years.

It is my honor to have been part of the CCC legacy which now spans nearly 45 years. Over this time we have served countless children and their families, shepherding generations through their early years. CCC alumni parents Richard Wells and Kathleen Bailey put it very well in expressing their appreciation for the experience their children received at CCC: *"CCC gave our kids a great foundation, teaching them ways to see, approach, and care for their community and the world in a way that has served them very well on their journeys so far. When children learn to live this way, it improves their lives and leads to a more peaceful and caring world."*

On behalf of the entire CCC community, I would like to thank those donors past and present who have contributed to our success. We are particularly grateful to those who made a gift during the 2017-2018 school year and happy to recognize them here. The generosity of our donors helps us to fulfill our mission of engaging, preparing, and inspiring today's children. 

Concord Children's Center FY 18 Operating Expenses




2017-2018 CCC Snapshot

During the 2017-2018 school year, CCC served 242 children from 189 families from 19 towns. Almost 80 percent of our families came from Concord. Thanks to the generosity of the Concord-Carlisle Community Chest, the Trinitarian Congregational Church, and the state voucher program, we were able to offer tuition assistance to 11 percent of our families.

2017-2018 Fundraising Events

Book Shop Fundraiser

Our annual fundraiser at the Concord Bookshop, a day when the Bookshop donates a portion of the day's proceeds back to CCC, took place on November 18, 2017. The event was well-attended and raised **\$1,179.50**, the most in the past five years.

Family Ice Skating Party

This year's family ice skating party took place on Sunday, January 28, at Nashoba Valley Olympia. The theme of the party was "The Big Red Ice Skating Party" and featured an appearance by Clifford the Big Red Dog. The afternoon raised **\$1,864**.

Auction

The 2018 CCC Auction with the theme of "Carnaval" was held on April 7 at Tri-Con. The evening raised **\$30,338.08**, significantly more than any auction in the past ten years (with the exception of the 2016 40th anniversary gala and auction). Around 135 people attended the event, which was led by auction co-chairs Tara Martin and Lindsey Dempsey.

Spring Fundraiser

On April 29, 2018, CCC hosted a family concert featuring Radius Ensemble performing an internationally-focused family program. The event was supported by a grant from the Concord Cultural Council.
