2019 – 2020 TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATION

Through a grant from the Concord-Carlisle Community Chest and the fundraising efforts of the Concord Children's Center, limited tuition assistance is available to qualifying families. Tuition assistance decisions are made without regard to the race, sex, religion, cultural heritage, political beliefs, marital status or sexual preference of the applicant. The average amount of tuition assistance which is available is between 10% to 25% of the monthly tuition. Tuition assistance is granted annually based upon available funding. Decisions regarding eligibility are made as applications for assistance are received. Notification of awards will occur in July once we are informed of the amount of funding be available. Please see eligibility on the reverse side of this application.
