- 1975 Chateau Brane-Cantenac. Chateau Brane-Cantenac is a second-growth estate in the Margaux village of Bordeaux and is among the region's exceptional properties. The 1975 Bordeaux vintage is considered classic but taking a long time to reach maturity. This wine offers perfumed notes of cedar, kirsch, dried berries, herbs, and violets.
- 1975 Chateau Suduiraut, A half-bottle (375ml) of white dessert wine from the Bordeaux region of

Sauternes. Expect notes of honeysuckle, ginger, nectarine, and ripe pear in this viscous sweet wine.
